On UNESCO's World Heritage List

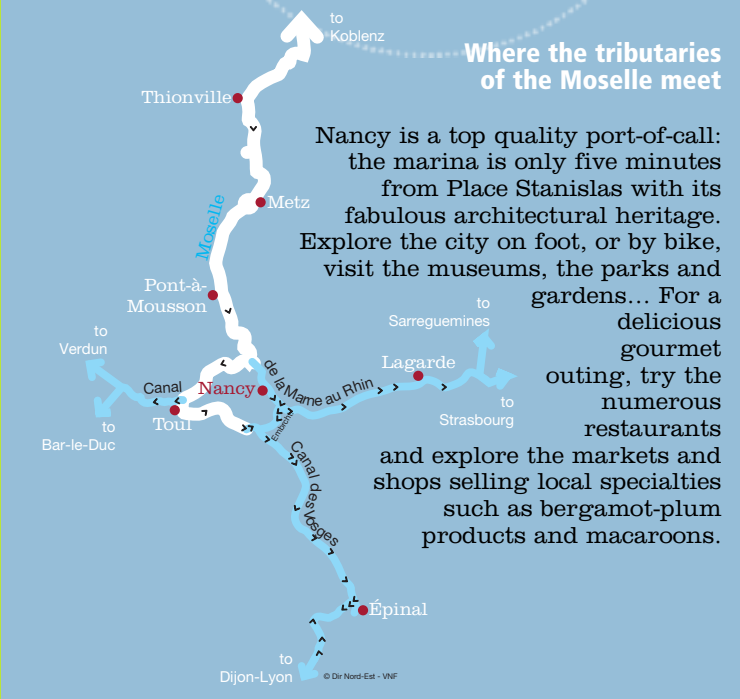
Nancy, capital of the Dukes' of Lorraine, a city of golden gates, has a magnificent 18thC architectural ensemble that includes Place Stanislas.

A port with a special welcome

In the midst of water-gardens and only a few minutes on foot from the city centre with all its shops, the port of Nancy is in delightful, peaceful surroundings, with flowers in season and numerous activities in summer. Lying between the Meurthe and the canal, nature is always near at hand; just go for a walk on the banks of the Meurthe!

All modern facilities

- The Harbour-Master's Office: reception, washrooms and information for tourists
- 40 berths with water and electrical connections
- The pontoons are locked for your security
- Security guards during the summer season
- Slipway and reception quay for new arrivals
- Selective rubbish disposal (glass, plastics, paper, batteries...)
- Free access liquid waste disposal (waste-water, engine oil)
- Objects floating in the canal removed
- 6 camper-van sites: washrooms, water and electricity laid on
- Telephone booth
- Wi-Fi zone

The Harbour-Master's Office is open 7-days a week all year round.



Making the environment top priority

The Port has been awarded the Blue Flag every year since 2005.

The port of Nancy has taken a number of actions in favour of sustainable development: reduction in waste products, selective waste sorting, energy and water consumption controls, respect for the site and protection of its flora and fauna. A free, unrestricted access waste liquid disposal unit has been built to prevent waste products being discharged in Nancy marina area. At the same time the Marne-Rhine Canal port's aquatic ecosystem is carefully maintained. The patrol-boat, Pélican, surveys the Canal for possible pollution, collecting floating objects to ensure the environment remains enjoyable and healthy.
